Consensual Non-Monogamy: Swinging, Polyamory, and Monogamish Relationships, presented by Jeannie Colvin, LMFT



Course Description: Some couples or individuals decide their sexuality does not fit within a monogamous relationship. Because of a significant amount of social and psychological stigma attached to these relationship choices, many people feel isolated in their decisions. This training will review the limited research available and will focus on understanding the common experiences people entering and remaining in consensual non-monogamous relationships face, concentrating primarily on Swinging and Polyamorous relationships. Therapists will be better informed, so they can help clients navigating these relationships.
